Site assessment activities conducted on 10/20/2017

SB-13 (was misplaced on the sketch sent 10/20)

- Advance boring to 50'bgs
- No GW observed within boring
- No visible impact observed
- Competent sandstone bedrock from 20' to 50'bgs
- Safely covered boring and left open to see if any water develops over the weekend.
- No soil samples submitted, as insufficient soil/bedrock from 20' to 50'bgs

MW-16

- Set well at 35" bgs
- GW observed at approximately 28'bgs
- Odor within smear zone of GW table
- Submit 30-30.5'bgs
- Insufficient soil for TD sample

MW-14

- Set well at 14' bgs
- GW observed at approximately 5'bgs
- No observed impacts
- Submit 5-7' and 14-16' bgs

MW-15

- Set well at 24' bgs
- GW observed at approximately 16'bgs
- No observed impacts
- Submit 15-17'bgs
- Insufficient soil for TD sample

Planned assessment for 10/23/17 – One Rig for the week (two coming next) Assess up gradient of MW-03 and north of MW-07. Continue to develop and sample groundwater monitoring wells.
