1	Drilling/Completion Operations	The first well on this wellpad was logged with an open-hole Resistivity Log and Gamma Ray Log from the kick-off point into the surface casing. All wells on the pad will have a cement bond log with gamma-ray run on production casing (or on intermediate casing if production liner is run) into the surface casing. The horizontal portion of every well will be logged with a measured-while-drilling gamma-ray log. The Form 5, Completion Report, for each well on the pad will list all logs run and have those logs attached. The Form 5 for a well without open-hole logs shall clearly state "No open-hole logs were run. The Hebron 02-07H, API No. 05-057-06499, was previously drilled and open-hole logs were run in this well".

Permit	This is a planned additional well on the pad. No change in waste management program. Preliminary review complete.	10/13/2017
Engineer	Offset water well check: COGCC evaluated offset water wells within one mile of this proposed well's surface hole location. This information was used in addition to locally-available geophysical logs and hydrogeologic information to evaluate the adequacy of the operator's proposed surface casing setting depth. The deepest water well within one mile is 140 feet. The Coalmont Formation is considered a potential freshwater resource in the North Park Basin (CGS Ground Water Atlas of Colorado, 2003). The proposed surface casing setting depth of 2500' will not cover the entire Coalmont Formation, based on the operator's drilling prognosis in the drilling plan. Minimum cement isolation standards are specified in Condition of Approval #2. Offset well evaluation: Reviewed offset well DA well Peterson #1 API # 057-06195. Shallow offset. Meets standards for offset Niobrara stimulation.	10/10/2017
