The following comments were provided by members of the public and were considered during the technical review of this application.

1	<p>Terminated Lease for NW/4, Section 4, 2N68W (Elms Neighborhood)</p> <p>Kerr-McGee does not have a valid lease with the homes and HOA in the Elms neighborhood in the NW/4 of Section 4, 2N68W, of which I am a mineral homeowner and mineral co-owner in the Elms Community Association.</p> <p>Kerr-McGee will need to pursue new leases with mineral rights owners in this area before being able to pool our area with the Hergenreder and Newby lands in the 240 and 480 acre spacing units of each of the 7 proposed Hergenreder wells.</p> <p>On March 19, 2006, Kerr-McGee violated the lease terms of their 1970 lease applicable to the Elms area minerals when:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">•KMG did not resume production of gas for the Elms from the Adam George GU-1 well for 60 days (JSand well was plugged), or•KMG did not initiate a new well serving the Elms area within the same 60 days. <p>KMG continued to violate the lease terms on October 7, 2006 when they did not pay Delay Rent on the lease anniversary.</p> <p>In addition, on August 29, 2016, Kerr-McGee violated the lease terms of their 1970 lease when:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">•KMG did not resume production of gas for the Elms area from any of the Adam Farm 8-4, 21-4 and 28-4 wells for 60 days (wells were shut-in 6/1/16 and 7/1/16), or•KMG did not initiate a new well serving the Elms within the same 60 days. <p>KMG continued to violate the lease terms on October 7, 2016 when they did not pay Delay Rent on the lease anniversary.</p>	09/26/2017
