Colorado State Logan County Luft Field  
9 (Well No.) D.Knudson (Lease) 17 NW $\frac{1}{4}$  (Sec. and  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec.) 8N (Twp.) 53W (Range) 6th P.M. (Meridian)

The well is located 2310 ft. (N) of North line and 330 ft. (E) of West  
Line Sec. 17 (S) (W)

The elevation above sea level is 4192' K.B.  
4180' Gr. ft.

Details of Plan of Work: (State names of and expected depths to objective sands:  
 Show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cement-  
 ing points, and all other important proposed work.)

The above described well was drilled to a total depth of  
 5025'. 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " OD casing was cemented @ 5010' K.B. and cement was  
 drilled to 4988' K.B. Drilling mud was displaced with crude oil  
 and a Gama Ray Log with collar locator was run on May 17, 1955  
 (Lane Wells).

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The 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing was perforated in the Dakota "D" sand from  
 4856' to 4861' K.B. with 6-15/32" bullets per foot, (Lane Wells).  
 Swabbing of well resulted in recovery of little oil above top  
 load and the well was given sand/oil treatment (Halliburton) using  
 200# sand and 2500 gal. lease crude. Sand/oil fluid was swabbed  
 from well, tubing was run and well placed on the pump May 29, 1955.  
 Initial Production for 24 hours was 24 bbls. oil and 1 bbl. water.
