The proposed location for the BMC F Pad is at the southeast corner of the Planned Unit Development (PUD). This location is proposed as a Temporary Water Facility containing 100 frac tanks with connecting pipelines to support completion of gas wells. The use of this BMC F Pad will reduce truck traffic, dust and potential accidents making the community safer. This pads location is not near BMSA residents and will be out of our sight.
