Request authority to move location 75 feet due east of prescribed location in C NW NW SW Section 14-8N-53W because of the location of the North Sterling Irrigation Ditch which runs through the lease.

We propose to drill the above well to an approximate depth of 4800 feet as a continuation of development of the Muddy and Dakota sandstone reservoirs underlying this lease and to meet offset production.

8 5/8-inch surface casing will be cemented at approximately 600 feet.

In the event commercial production is encountered 5 1/2-inch casing will be cemented at or near total depth.

We will Stratafrac the productive interval if necessary.
