5502-5513 - 11' 0"

Siltstone with shale, thinly laminated

5513-5513.3- 0' 3"

Shale, fissile

5513.3-5517 - 3' 9"

Siltstone, light gray, silty, sandy,
thinly laminated, with shale.

5517-5518 - 1' 0"

Siltstone and shale, thinly laminated

5518-5528 - 10' 0"

Sandstone, light gray, fine grained, subangular,
subround, porous, thinly carbonaceous partings,
dull yellow fluorescence, light stain.
From visual observation, looks wet - very
wet towards bottom.

5528-5539 - 11' 0"

Sandstone, very fine grained, silty, with
chist and carbonaceous shale, all slightly
reworked.

5539-5541 - 2' 0"

Sandstone, gray, fine grained, hard and tight,
slightly carbonaceous, no stain, no fluorescence.

5541-5543 - 2' 0"

Sandstone, gray, phosphorous, carbonaceous;
samples in core catcher - sandstone, light
gray, medium to fine grained, subangular,
subround, porous, light stain, bright yellow
fluorescence.
