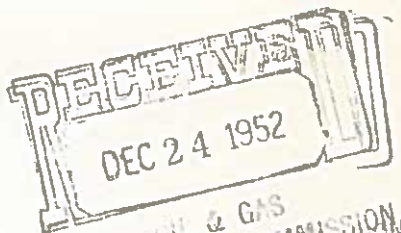

The well is located 330 ft. (X) of N Line and 995 ft. (E) of _____

W Line of NW/4 Section 20-8N-53W.

The elevation above sea level is 4187 ft.

Details of Plan of Work: (State names of and expected depths to objective sands: Show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

We propose to plug and abandon the captioned well by placing a cement plug from 4864 feet (total depth) to 4850 feet opposite the 'Muddy' sandstone. Heavy mud taken from the bottom of the mud pit will then be placed from 4850' to 625' (15 feet below the bottom of surface casing). A cement plug will then be spotted to 595' with heavy mud being from 595' to 15', where a cement plug will be spotted to the surface in such a manner as not to interfere with surface cultivation.*
