On August 17, 1952 the 5-1/2" OD 15.5# J-55 casing was perforated opposite the oil bearing sand from 4818-4828' with 6 knne shots per foot by Lane Wells. Ran 4841' of 2-3/8" OD 4.7# J-55 tubing and set at 4838' ground. The initial production was 60 bbls. of oil for 5 hours test. Well died. Awaiting installation of pumping equipment.
