

Oil Based Mud Waste Management Plan Noble Energy, Inc.

Noble Energy, Inc. (Noble) will dispose of oil based mud (OBM) in accordance with the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission's (COGCC) Rule 907 Management of E&P Waste. Noble will transport OBM as E&P Waste to an offsite disposal facility in Colorado which is approved by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment.

Noble will transport OBM under proper waste manifest and will retain each manifest for not less than five years. The criteria on the manifest will include A) The date of transport B) The identity of the waste generator C) The identity of the waste transporter D) The location of the waste pick up site E) The type and volume of waste, and F) the name of the location of the disposal site.

Noble will follow COGCC Rule 907.d (2) Treatment and Disposal of Drilling Fluids. Noble will dispose of drilling fluids by Injection into a Class II well permitted in accordance with COGCC Rule 325 or disposal at a commercial solid waste disposal facility.
