



Plan of Development

Access: Existing access. Minor maintenance may be necessary prior to start of completions operations.

Flowback: NR 23-3 Pad or RWF 512-11 Frac Pad

Completions: Completions will utilize the RWF 512-11 Frac Pad as a remote frac support pad for the NR 23-3 pad. An existing temporary 10" poly surface water supply line (±15,765') from the existing valve can to the RWF 512-11 Frac Pad will be utilized to deliver water to the frac pad. One temporary booster pump will be required along the water supply line route at the RWF 311-15 Pad. 3-4.5" steel temporary surface frac lines (±8,990') will be installed from the RWF 512-11 Frac Pad to the NR 23-3 pad following existing roads.
