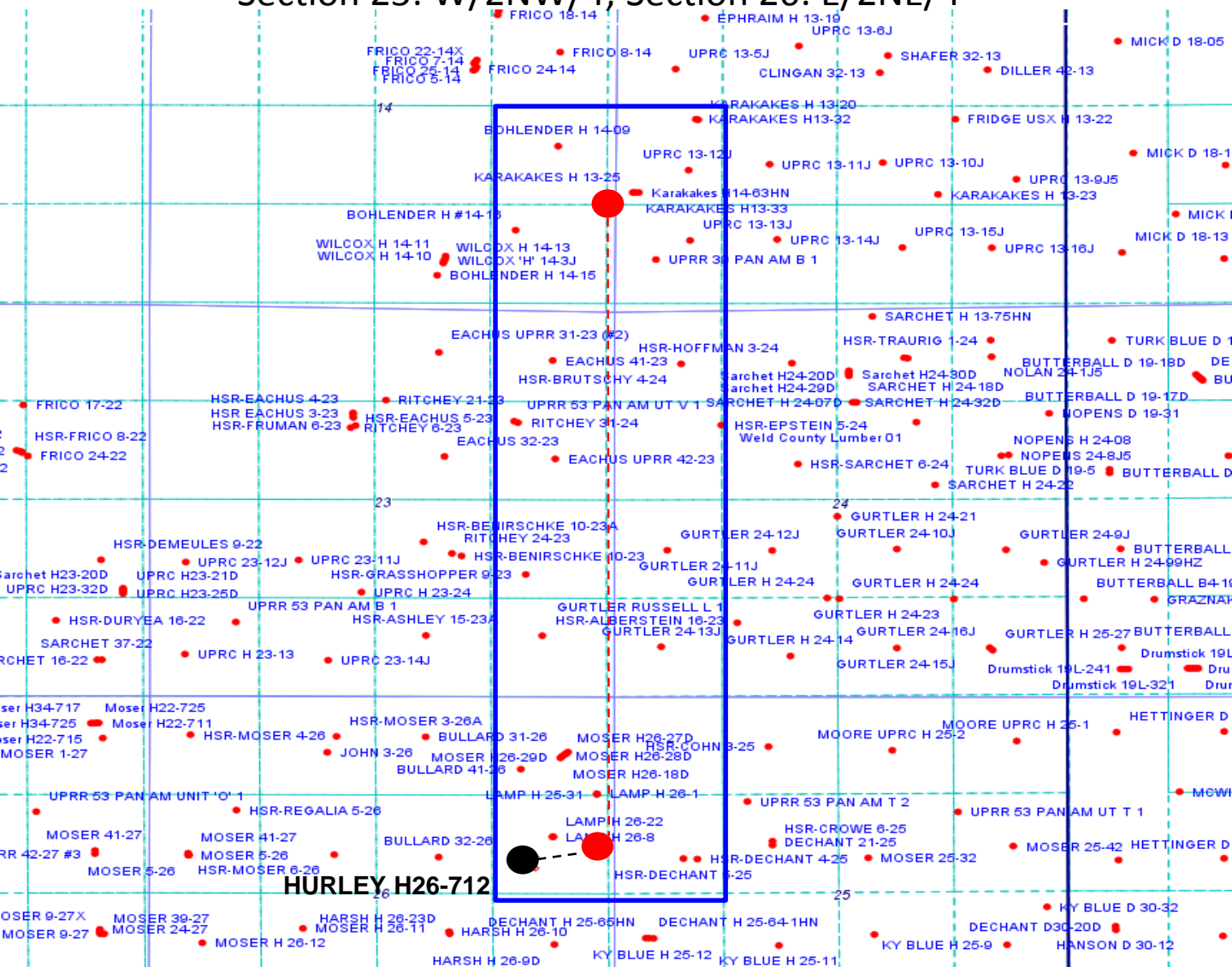
Proposed Spacing Unit – Noble Energy, Inc

Township 3 North, Range 65 West

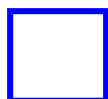
