General Comment:

Environmental Site Inspection in response to spill report doc #401533991. Sunny and pleasant (temperature around 50 oF). Approximately five barrels of sludge were reportedly spilled out of a tank that was being torn down by a third-party contractor. The contractor built a berm around the spill and contained the spill. Spilled sludge was removed by a vac truck. At the time of this inspection, the tank had been moved to the cut slope. It was empty and no sludge or liquid was observed in it. The circular berm was observed at the center of the yard with no sludge or any type of fluid inside. Soil inside of the bermed area and the berm itself presented no odor or staining. According to Caerus, soil samples were taken and sent to the lab. The yard is used by Caerus for temporary storage and other activities related to the Oil & Gas operation. The pad is bermed. No staining, junk or vegetation growth was observed on site.
