Chris,
Thanks for the phone conversation yesterday. As we talked about, we can consider yesterdays conversation a pre consult for the re occupation of the Boies pad. See below.

CPW staff consulted with Chris McRickard on November 28, 2017 regarding the B-30H-H2 well located on the Boies pad in Rio Blanco County at the NESE,S30, T2S, R97W.

A review of COGCC's web site did not reveal information related to the pad's date of construction or spud dates for the wells located on the pad. No wildlife COA's were documented on any of the forms in the records searched. The approved Form 2 did not contain wildlife BMPs.

A search of internal CPW records found no documentation of consultation.

The Boies pad is an existing pad and presumably constructed prior to 1298 regulations requiring consultation; additionally, with no record of wildlife BMPs, and located in close proximity to county roads, numerous existing well pads and oil and gas roads and support facilities new drilling and completion activities on this existing site does not warrant wildlife BMPs.
