Ian & Andrea,

We are working to complete our review and approve the referenced Form 2A Oil & Gas Location Assessment and would like a few more pieces of information.

1) When this Form 2A was submitted, you had indicated the date planned to commence construction would be 1/30/18 and the date interim reclamation would begin would be 6/30/18. Please provide an update to these two dates.

2) Given the remoteness of the area where this location is being permitted in regards to pipeline infrastructure, will you provide some information as to any plans CCRP Operating has in place or are working on to pipe out any gas that is produced from these wells. The COGCC is seeing a lot of permits being submitted for this part of the state and are concerned with how salable quality gas will be handled. Ideally we'd like to see all salable quality gas send to a sales pipeline immediately and are wondering if operators are actively working with midstream pipeline companies to achieve this out there.

Andrew,

Thanks for your e-mail. Here is some more information around your questions 1 & 2:

1. At the time the original 2A was submitted there was uncertainty on obtaining a SUA with the landowner in section 10. We had hoped to have a SUA completed by December 2017; Unfortunately that date was missed and pushed to February 2018. With a SUA now in place we intend to commence construction 6/1/2018 with a date interim reclamation of 12/1/2018.
2. CCRP intends gather gas from the 11 Salt Ranch pads (as indicated on the 2A facilities diagram). Accomplishing the Salt Ranch SUA, which took around 8 months to finish and encompasses 11 pads (and is designed to support ~150 wells) provided enough well count in a centralized location to have a meaningful discussion with existing and prospective gatherers. The importance of the SUA is further compounded given the Chalk Bluffs terrain and various conservation easements in the Stateline area. Since signing the SUA we have held meetings with 4 other parties to review possible partnerships for gas gathering. We recognize the importance of finding a gathering / processing solution to handling gas from this area and are in active discussions with Summit Midstream (who operates the gas gathering system in the Hereford area) and other parties who are interested in putting in a new system to service the area west of the Hereford field.
