General Comment:

Environmental inspection conducted in response to a notification concerning chemical bags stored on site and potential environmental impact due to dry material on the ground. This inspection only addresses environmental issues. COAs and comments on other inspections need to be addressed by Caerus, independently of this inspection.

On site with Jake Janicek from Caerus. Sunny and warm (around 60 oF). Bags had been removed from location. Soil had been scraped. Only traces of dark grey powder (presumably from the chemical bags) and some saw dust was observed on site. A small amount of a black fluid with no odor has been spilled on the southeast side of the location (about one foot diameter). It does not appear that E&P waste had been spilled on the ground. No E&P waste reportable spill was identified.

Caerus should determine if the chemicals released on the ground need to be reported to the CDPHE based on their regulations.
