Gentlemen:

Mr. Elmo Lewton was contacted by letter on April 17 concerning reports due on the subject well. He visited our office and showed me a copy of a letter from his attorney, Mr. Frank Allen, Jr., directed to you, and your answer dated April 24, 1963. Carbon copies of these letters were sent to me at our old address, 1162½ Elati Street, which I never received.

It is my understanding that the forms due are supposed to be submitted by you. To date, we have not received these forms. According to levy reports the well has been producing since the first of the year. It is necessary for all operators to submit production figures on our OGCC Form-7 (Monthly Production Report) each month. It is also required that an OGCC Form-10 (Certificate of Clearance) be filed whenever there is a change of operator or transporter.

The present bond on the well is in the name of William H. Young. The bonding company has requested a release of this bond but we cannot release it until the present operator files a bond in his name. If the bonding requirements are to fall under your waiver, it will be necessary for you to file the delinquent reports before we can release Mr. Young's bond. *Lee*

We are anxious to get the requirements on this well taken care of as early as possible. Your cooperation in attending to the matter at your earliest opportunity is requested.
