(the "Lands")

Per the COGCC DJ Basin Horizontal Offset Policy, any existing oil and gas wells within 1500' of a proposed horizontal wellbore that does not have adequate protection and isolation over the treated wellbore. Your Lands currently have two wells that do not meet COGCC standards and must be mitigated prior to Mallard's hydraulic fracturing operations:

- Frank 35-9 (API: 05-123-21377)
- Frank 35-15 (API: 05-123-20170)

Mallard is required to enter your Lands in order to locate, unearth, re-enter, and mitigate these existing plugged and abandoned wells prior to hydraulic fracturing operations. This process will take approximately ten days from commencement to completion.


