OPERATOR COMMENTS AND SUBMITTAL

Comments The distance to the completed portion of the nearest well on the "Spacing & Formations" tab was measured to the proposed Rinn Valley East N17-20-7C in 2D via COGCC GIS Mapping. The distance to the closest well belonging to another operator on the "Drilling & Waste Plans" tab was measured to Crestone Peak's File 32-17 well. Distance was measured 3D via the anti-collision report (attached as "other") because when measured in 2D via COGCC GIS Mapping, the File 4-2-17 well appears to intersect the proposed wellbore but they it is actually 290' away.

The surface owner has waived Rules 318A.a. & 318A.c. in the SUA, highlighted on page 6 of the attached SUA.

All wells on the pad will have a cement bond log with gamma-ray run on production casing (or on intermediate casing if production liner is run) into the surface casing. The horizontal portion of every well will be logged with a measured-while-drilling gamma-ray log. The Form 5, Completion Report, for each well on the pad will list all logs run and have those logs attached. The Form 5 for a well without open-hole logs shall clearly state "No open-hole logs were run" and shall clearly identify (by API#, well name & number) the well in which open-hole logs were run.
4	Noise mitigation	Noise levels will be assessed as necessary and mitigation measures such as, but not limited to, sound walls will be implemented to maintain compliance with Rule 802. and 604.c.(2).A.
