Ursa Operating Company (Ursa) is requesting the API's listed below get included in the previously approved exception to the ground water sampling rule 609 as outlined in COGCC Rule 609.c (1) dated 4/4/2017 (Doc#401249292). As previously stated on the prior exception & approval, no suitable water wells being present within the 1/2 mile radius. One (1) water well (permit # 0051650) was noted ~1900ft to the east per the DWR website, but after further investigation, it was determined it was a groundwater monitoring well used for site investigation activities in 2013 and is not plotted correctly as there is no water well in that area.
