2017

2017 SUMMARY

The NPR Solidification Facility, permitted as a non-commercial Centralized E&P Facility (426582) previously belonged to Encana, having been acquired by Caerus Piceance LLC on July 25th, 2017. The NPR Solidification Facility is in SENW Sec 29, T5S, R95W. During 2017, the facility was in use 2-3 days per week, which was decreased from previously levels.

Volumes brought in: 1,943 bbl.

Volumes hauled out: 868 cubic yards

Volumes hauled from the NPR Solidification Facility are taken to a commercial E&P facility permitted to accept the material.

2018 UPDATE AND FUTURE OPERATIONS

The facility continues to be in the Caerus field operating plan for the foreseeable future. In 2018, it is expected that the NPR Solidification Facility will continue to handle decreased volumes of material and will be in operation just a few days per week.

MONITORING WELLS AND WATER SAMPLING

There are roughly nine (9) permitted monitoring wells near or downstream of the NPR Solidification Facility. These monitoring wells are sampled regularly.

INSPECTIONS, SPILLS, RELEASES OR ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

There were no identified enforcement actions, inspections or spills at this facility in 2017.
