Dear Ms. Murphy,

Extraction Oil & Gas respectfully requests that the Director grant an exception COGCC Rule 603.a.(2) for the subject well as it will be located less than 150' from a surface property line.

COGCC Rule 603.a.(2)

A well shall be located not less than one hundred fifty (150) feet from a surface property line. The Director may grant an exception if it is not feasible for the Operator to meet this minimum distance requirement and a waiver is obtained from the offset Surface Owner(s). An exception request letter stating the reasons for the exception shall be submitted to the Director and accompanied by a signed waiver(s) from the offset Surface Owner(s). Such waiver shall be written and filed in the county clerk and recorder's office and with the Director.

The Rinn Valley East N17-20-8N well is spotted 143' from a property line. The location was chosen to maximize future land use possibilities, minimize surface disturbance and satisfy the wishes of the surface owner. The surface owner also owns the offset property parcel and has signed an Exception Location Waiver for Rule 603.a.(2) which is attached to the APD labeled "Exception Location Waiver". A Surface Use Agreement with the surface owner was also signed on 1/28/2018 and is also attached to the APD.
