Dear Director Murphy,

Magpie Operating, Inc. (Magpie) is planning to drill three (3) horizontal wells on the above referenced pad:

<b>Campion 5-6 #1H</b>	<b>386' FNL 1880' FWL</b>	<b>Section 5-T4N-R68W</b>	<b>Doc #401589736</b>
<b>Campion 5-6 #2H</b>	<b>386' FNL 1820' FWL</b>	<b>Section 5-T4N-R68W</b>	<b>Doc #401589738</b>
<b>Campion 32-31 #1H</b>	<b>386' FNL 1850' FWL</b>	<b>Section 5-T4N-R68W</b>	<b>Doc #401589739</b>

The surface location of Magpie's proposed wells have been staked outside of the Colorado Oil & Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) Rule 318A.a. Greater Wattenberg Area (GWA) Drilling Window.

COGCC Rule 318A.c. states that any new well is to be located within 50 feet of an existing well. The proposed wells are being permitted as exception locations since they are located greater than 50 feet from the nearest existing well. The proposed wells are located approximately 326-363 feet from the Peterson 2 well.

Magpie has obtained written permission to place these wells as exception locations by virtue of a signed surface use agreement with the surface owner. Waiver language is included on page 4, paragraph 10.3 of the signed surface use agreement.

Magpie respectfully requests the COGCC approve the request for exception locations and Applications for Permit to Drill for the wells on the subject pad. Many thanks for your consideration of this matter.
