Based on data collected by the previous operator of the Smith Elsie GU #1 facility (Amoco), the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) requested that Kerr-McGee conduct additional subsurface assessment activities at this tank battery to determine the extent and magnitude of any potential historic soil and or groundwater petroleum hydrocarbon impacts. Soil and groundwater assessment began in May 2008, and petroleum hydrocarbon impacts to soil and groundwater were encountered.

Groundwater monitoring wells MW04 through MW09 and MW11 through MW13 are sampled on a quarterly basis and submitted for laboratory analysis for benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and total xylenes (BTEX) by United States Environmental Protection Agency Method 8260C. The monitoring well locations are depicted on Figure 1. The Groundwater Elevation Contour Map generated using the May 2018 survey data is provided as Figure 2. The groundwater analytical results are summarized in Table 1, and the laboratory analytical report for the May 2018 groundwater monitoring event is attached.

Groundwater Monitoring will continue on a quarterly basis until a No Further Action status request is warranted.
