Dear Ms. Murphy,

Extraction Oil & Gas respectfully requests that the Director grant an exception to Rule 603.a(2) for the Raindance 29E-10-4C well, Document Number 401544806. The subject well is located in accordance with the Surface Use Agreement, in order to maximize future land use possibilities and minimize surface disturbance. Per Rule 603.a(2) of the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC), the surface location of a well must be no less than 150' from a property line. The subject well is 142' from the adjacent property line. The adjacent property owner is the same owner of the parcel in which the wellhead is located. Specific details waiving the rule are under the SUA, Section 2.
