

**Edge Energy II LLC
E&P Waste Management Plan**

Edge Energy II LLC's (Edge) plans for the appropriate handling of produced water, drill mud and cuttings, tank bottoms, and other associated Exploration and Production (E & P) wastes as described by COGCC Rule 907.

E&P wastes onsite will be stored in compatible containers or containment devices designed or engineered for the purposes for which they will be utilized. These containers will be inspected on a regular basis to ensure that no undue wear, structural issues, severe rust, other defects, which may impact their effectiveness.

E&P wastes will be transported offsite via truck by a licensed transporter to a licensed third-party solid waste disposal facility/landfill. Frequency of these operations will vary by site based on waste volumes.

Any soils contaminated by E&P waste will be disposed of at a licensed third-party solid waste disposal facility/landfill. Tank bottoms will be disposed of at licensed third-party solid waste disposal facilities.

Liquid wastes such as flow-back fluid and produced water will be disposed of at licensed third-party injection facilities such as those run by NGL Water Solutions.
