Comment:

The previous corrective action required PDC to reclaim the access road. This was a shared location and a shared access road with KPK and KPK has active operations; therefore, KPK is responsible for Final Reclamation activities at this location. KPK confirmed with COGCC Staff they still use this access road and will maintain the access road.

PDC stated that weeds were managed in response to the previous corrective action inspection (FIRR Document #401676081). It is now the responsibility of KPK to manage and control weeds per Rule 1004 standards.

Since KPK has active operations, this is a well release on an active location. No further action is required by PDC.
