INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

One soil sample (SS01) was collected below the partially buried produced water vessel at approximately 5 feet below ground surface (bgs). The soil sample was submitted for laboratory analysis of benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, total xylenes (BTEX), naphthalene, total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) – gasoline range organics (GRO) by United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Method 8260B, and TPH – diesel range organics (DRO) by USEPA Method 8015, pH by USEPA 9045, and electrical conductivity (EC) by Standard Method (SM) 2510B.

Proposed Soil Sampling

Four (4) additional soil samples will be collected in the location of the former sidewalls of the excavation area below the produced water vessel. Soil samples will be collected at 3 feet bgs, within the COGCC designated root zone. Soil samples will be submitted for laboratory analysis of BTEX, naphthalene, TPH - GRO by USEPA Method 8260B, TPH - DRO by USEPA Method 8015, pH by USEPA 9045, and EC by SM 2510B. In addition, three (3) soil samples will be collected from native material within the root zone to establish background conditions. Soil samples will be submitted for laboratory analysis of pH by USEPA 9045 and EC by SM 2510B.
