Todd,

I wanted to summarize our discussion yesterday while at the Chavez #1. Please continue with the plan of removing impacted material from around the well head and determining the vertical and lateral extent of the impacts. The Chavez water well will need to be sampled for the constituent list in Rule 609.e.2. A ground water sample from near the impacted area will also need to be collected.

Alamosa Drilling will need to submit a Form 19 Spill Report for the historic release at this location. The Initial report shall be submitted within 72 hours after discovery. Please refer to Rule 906.b for more information.

A Form 27 Site Investigation and Remediation Workplan will need to be submitted, per Rule 906.c, documenting the work done to date and anticipated remediation.
