 Field Inspector Actions:
 On 9-17-2018, I was contacted by supervisor Jason Gomez in reference to a complaint received by the COGCC in reference to noise. The complaint stated the noise occurred in the Erie area originating from the Extraction, Coyote location.
 On 9-17-2018, I contacted Erika Deakin who is one of the complainants by e-mail. I performed a complete site inspection of the Extraction location which was approx. 1 mile to the NE of the complaints home. I spoke with Joe Webser the fishing operation supervisor and Dustin Romance the production operator and reviewed there records, which did not show any abnormal conditions between 04:45 and 06:00 9-16-2018. I also spoke to Dillan Hein facility operator of the two neighboring wells and he also stated they had no abnormal operation during the times of the complaints. At the time of inspection I could not determine that the noise originated on any of the Oil and Gas facilities in the area.
 No violation of COGCC rules were observed at the time of the inspection of the fishing operations nor in the surrounding neighborhood.
 All information reviewed and site inspection information were submitted to the COGCC office for further review.
