The well is located 950 ft. (N) of N. Line and 987 ft. (E) of West Line of NW/4 Section 23-T8N-R53W.

The elevation above sea level is 4074 ft.

Details of Plan of Work: (State names of and expected depths to objective sands: Show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

The captioned well was temporarily abandoned 10-18-52, and as commercial production was not obtained, we propose to abandon it, by first removing the 5 1/2" casing, which was set at 4776 feet. We anticipate recovering approximately 3600 feet. Then a cement plug will be spotted from 4782 feet (Total Depth) to 4651 feet (opposite the 'Muddy' and Dakota sandstone). Heavy mud will then be placed from 4651 feet to 622 feet (15 feet below bottom of surface pipe). A cement plug will be set from 622 feet to 592 feet, heavy mud from there to 15 feet, with a 15 foot cement plug being spotted to the surface in such a manner as not to interfere with cultivation*.
