May 6, 1953. Reached total depth of 5136' K.B. Ran 170 joints 5-1/2" casing landed at 5135'KB. Four centralizers spaced at 5125', 5096', 5030' and 4995'. Scratchers spread from 5134 to 5090' and 5035 to 4935'. Casing cemented with 250 sax 3% Gel cement. Ran temperature survey and found top of cement behind casing at 4975'.
