We propose to drill the captioned well to a total depth of approximately 4900 feet to further evaluate the 'Muddy' and Dakota sandstones in the South Springdale Field.

8 5/8" surface casing will be set at approximately 200 feet and cemented to the surface.

4 1/2" casing will be cemented at approximately 4900 feet if commercial production is encountered and perforated opposite the 'Muddy' or Dakota ( which ever is productive). We will hydrafrac or acid treat the productive interval if necessary.
