

The well is located 422 ft. (N) of S Line and 330 ft. (W) of E Line of SE/4 Section 28-8N-53W

The elevation above sea level is 4089 ft.

Details of Plan of Work: (State names of and expected depths to objective sands; Show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

We propose to plug and abandon the captioned well by placing heavy mud taken from the bottom of the mud pits, from 5143 feet (total depth) to 4900 feet. A cement plug will be spotted from 4900 feet to 4690 feet, opposite the Muddy' and Dakota sandstone. Heavy mud will again be placed from 4690 feet to 630 feet. A cement plug will be put from 630 feet to 520 feet (bottom of surface casing being at 578 feet). Heavy mud will be placed from 520 feet to 10 feet, where a cement plug will be spotted to the surface in such a manner as not to interfere with surface cultivation.
