> We had a possible spill that was found 8/24/18 at around 10:35 AM by Norwest on the Leah 23-5 well site (API# 05-071-08765-) The vendor found the unlined production pit to be seeping water, the level in the pit was approximately ½ full and is possibly seeping through the fill slope. Water trucks will be dispatched to drain the pit. We are unable to determine the amount at this time and can only estimate between 1-50 bbls of produced water has seeped out. The spill saturated the ground to the North and entered a dry drainage with mild saturation (no flowing) that was considered waters of the state with no live water. A call was made to the CDPHE spill hotline.
