DETAILS OF WORK

Plugged back with sand, 4939' to 4750'; spotted 5 sacks of cement, 4750' to 4695'. Shot casing loose. Recovered 117 jts., 3710', of 4½" casing. Kept hole full of heavy mud. Placed 10 sacks of cement, 155' to 105'; mud, 105' to 25'; 5 sacks of cement, 25' to surface.

Left 1252' of 4½" casing in hole, 3722-4974'.

Left 158' of 7" surface casing in hole.
