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Following is an update on the COGCC's investigation in response to the discovery of dissolved methane, ethane, and propane in your domestic water well.

1. COGCC required companies operating oil & gas wells located within 0.75-miles of you water well to provide your residence with an alternate supply of water.
  - a. Boulder Water has installed a temporary system with two (2) aboveground water tanks piped into you residence. Boulder Water is maintaining that system and delivering water.
2. Companies operating oil & gas wells located within 0.75-miles of you water well were required to submit information on the construction and operational history of their wells.
  - a. COGCC engineering staff are reviewing those submittals to assess potential well integrity issues.
3. Production gas samples were collected from the above-mentioned oil & gas wells and submitted for laboratory analysis.
  - a. COGCC environmental staff are evaluating the analytical results.
4. As a precautionary measure, ground water samples are being collected from 10 domestic water wells located within 0.5-miles of your water well.
