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Good morning, John,

As we chatted about on the phone this morning, and since you were not involved in the original discussions, we had asked your colleague at Crestone Peak to refrain from reclaiming the Adam Ten 1-A vertical well location.

Confluence's original plans for 2018 included potentially drilling up to two new wells on our Missouri 31 location, which is directly adjacent to the Adam Ten 1-A location. We figured that we'd disturb any newly reclaimed ground as we built our pad, so best not to waste money reclaiming. Turns out that we did not drill new wells there this year, and I apologize for not communicating that to you guys.

As it also turns out, Confluence is the surface owner of the 40 acre parcel (SE/SE Sec 31) that your Adam Ten 1-A location resides on. Given that you guys have an obligation to the COGCC to reclaim your pad, we're fine with you proceeding with that work. We do ask, however, that you please request a variance to keep the two-track access road that currently runs north from WCR 2 into location. We will plan to use that road and existing Weld County access when we build our Missouri pad.
