**Plan of Development**

TEP Rocky Mountain LLC ("TEP") proposes the installation and operation of one (1) compressor on the TR 44-35-597 pad to provide compression for thirteen (13) existing Trail Ridge wells that are currently low producing or currently shut-in due to higher line pressure. These well have difficulty producing into the higher pressure pipeline. All construction activities will be location within the existing disturbance of the TR 44-35-597 pad. TEP would install one (1) AJAX 360 Compressor and one (1) low pressure separator adjacent to the compressor. Existing production equipment on the TR 44-35-597 pad will remain in place and consist of one (1) single separator, two (2) 400bbl produced water tank, and two (2) 300bbl condensate tanks. Three (3) new pipelines would be installed to support operation of the proposed compressor. One (1) six-inch (6") steel gas pipeline (gas gathering; approx. 350') would be installed from the existing four-inch (4") low pressure gas pipeline west of the pad location to the low-pressure separator and into the suction inlet of the compressor. One (1) four-inch (4") steel gas pipeline (gas gathering; approx. 325') would be installed from the discharge outlet of the compressor to the existing four-inch (4") steel gas pipeline located west of the pad location, which ties into the an existing eight-inch (8") gas pipeline. One (1) two-inch (2") flexpipe fluid dump line (on location flowline; approx. 95') will be installed from the proposed low-pressure separator to the existing separators on location. All proposed pipeline installed within the disturbance boundary of the TR 44-35-597 pad location. See above for additional details.
