Notice Letter
Water Disposal Well Conversion

To whom this may concern:

This notice letter shall satisfy notification requirements prescribed by the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (the "Commission") for the conversion of an existing well to a water disposal well and will serve as an acknowledgement from Merit Energy Partners regarding the proposed water disposal well.

Chevron U.S.A. Inc., as Operator of the Rangely Weber Sand Unit (the "Operator"), has applied to the Commission for the authority to convert the UP 113X22 located in Section 22, Township 2 North, Range 102 West, Rio Blanco County (lawfully included within the boundaries of the Unit) from an oil well that has been temporarily abandoned, to a water disposal well disposing fluids into the Navajo formation, a subsurface strata not included within the unit but otherwise covered by the oil and gas lease covering the above-described lands. Such disposal operations are reasonably required for efficient development of the underlying oil and gas leasehold and lands lawfully unitized therewith.

The conversion of the existing temporarily abandoned well to the proposed water disposal well shall not affect Operator's existing surface use rights of the above-described lands, whether to enlarge or reduce such rights. As Operator, we have determined that the proposed operations and use of the well for water disposal will have no adverse effect upon drinking water, surface integrity or health and safety, although the Commission has the legislative charge to make that determination. As Operator, we will continue to comply with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, statutes and regulations.

Any person who would be directly and adversely affected or aggrieved by the authorization of the underground disposal into the proposed injection zone may file, within 15 days of

notification, a written request for a public hearing before the Commission, provided such request meets the protest requirements specified in COGCC Rule 325 m.
