SOURCE REMOVAL SUMMARY

Describe how source is to be removed.

The source impacts will be removed via excavation of impacted soil above COGCC Table 910-1 standards for TPH-DRO, TPH-GRO, BTEX, and Naphthalene. Approximately 3000 cubic yards of impacted soil will be treated ex situ using chemical oxidation by applying hydrogen peroxide. The soil will be mixed by a track hoe and staged in 100 cubic yard piles for 24 hours prior to collecting confirmation soil samples. Every 100 cubic yards of treated material and overburden will be sampled by collecting a 4 point composite sample. Grab confirmation soil samples will be collected in the vadose zone of the excavation to confirm all impacts have been successfully removed. Source groundwater impacts will also be treated by mixing hydrogen peroxide into the saturated interval of the open excavation. Once the treated material is compliant with COGCC Table 910-1 standards, the material will then be used to backfill the excavation. All soil samples including confirmation samples in the vadose zone of the excavation, overburden samples, and treated soil samples will be delivered to a certified laboratory under proper chain of custody procedures and analyzed for TPH-DRO, TPH-GRO, BTEX, and Naphthalene by EPA Methods 8015 and 8260b.
