For the most recent field inspection report of this facility, please refer to document #688800349. This was a joint inspection with BLM staff members Jennifer Jardine and Tanner Nygren. The focus of this field inspection was from below the cliff face to the release end point in the wash. Hand crews were loading 5 gallon buckets with impacted material and placing it into totes to be airlifted out of the canyon for disposal.
