NGL Water Solutions DJ, LLC (NGL), hereby certifies that it has complied with Rule 306.e, which states that an Operator shall be available to meet with Building Unit Owners who received an OGLA notice or a buffer zone notice pursuant to Rule 305.c. and requested a meeting regarding the proposed oil and gas location. Notifications were sent and no detailed requests for a hearing were received. NGL did meet with concerned landowners and made an agreement that if the COGCC granted approval for a facility at South Weld, a surface trucking facility would not be constructed at the Roy (subject) site. COGCC has granted that request so there will be no tanks or truck loading at this facility; only wellheads and the insulating wellhead house.
