The impacted soil was removed via excavation activities completed on September 14, 2015. The dissolved benzene groundwater impacts exceeding the COGCC Table 910-1 Regulatory Limits will be removed using an insitu technology. Additional groundwater assessment is required. Impacted groundwater will be delineated by monitoring wells and monitored for natural attenuation.

REMEDIATION SUMMARY
