The Document notes that: "What appears to be surface owner equipment, vehicles, metal piping, and debris is placed around the interim reclamation area." The proposed corrective action states that WPX should: "Remove debris and reclaim, or provide a signed surface owner waiver letter taking responsibility for portions of the project area that they are utilizing."

The noted equipment, vehicles, metal piping and debris are neither within WPX Energy's project area, nor within the reclamation area. All the land owner's equipment is located outside of our anchor pattern and does not pose a problem either from a safety or an operational standpoint. Because WPX Energy does not have a surface use agreement on this well, a surface owner waiver is not a practical solution, nor does WPX Energy have the legal authority to remove the equipment and debris. If COGCC has additional documentation that clearly defines the project area, we would be grateful if you could share that with us.
