Incline Operating, LLC (Incline) has filed the Form 2A Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA) for the proposed oil and gas pad referenced above.

Pursuant to COGCC Rule 305.c., Incline certifies that the required notifications to all Building Unit Owners within the Buffer Zone Setback were sent and was available for meeting and/or consultation. Incline received two (2) request for consultation. The first consultation occurred on November 31, 2018 with the landowner to the south who had concerns about the dust, traffic, noise impacts, and equipment placement.
