Petro Operating Company, LLC (Petro) hereby certifies that it has complied with Rule 306.e, which states that an Operator shall be available to meet with Building Unit Owners who received an OGLA notice or a buffer zone notice pursuant to Rule 305.c. and requested a meeting regarding the proposed oil and gas location. The operator sent notices pursuant to Rule 305.c and Weld County WOGLA. Because of the Warehouse within 1000 feet of the proposed Production Facility a notice was sent and USE Real Estate Holdings, LLC (USE) objected initially and requested more information.
