Petition for Review

Dear Commissioners,

I am requesting a hearing and/or I beseech you to reopen my complaints and investigate the low frequency sound in my neighborhood.

As I write I am sitting at my kitchen table. The water in a nearby bottle is vibrating as if there is a sonic toothbrush inserted in it. I can feel a vibration through the floor and throughout my

body. The dull continuous sound that accompanies it is akin to a diesel engine/ a few houses away, yet it hasn't stopped in about a year. I have researched more than I would want to, the health effects of low frequency noise. I have went to an audiologist, been told I have excellent hearing and bought custom made silicone earplugs. I have a white noise machine, have spent several nights in hotel rooms and am beyond frustrated.

The noise I hear comes from a oil and gas location just east of 1st ave and 32nd street, Evans, CO. The location is not marked with any signs identifying or giving contact information. Two of the complaints I have filed have asked how I can find that out. I have never gotten a response, but that location has been referred to as PDC in some correspondence from you. The noise began with drilling and was much louder and more vibrating. The tone and vibration has changed but never stopped (except two times for about one hour).

The first complaint I submitted was followed with a professional sounding message on my answering machine saying it would be investigated, only to be followed 2 days later by an email saying it had been closed because I didn't call within 24 hours. I have that message, it says nothing about having to respond in 24 hours.

My next complaint resulted in a noise study that said, yes there is a sound, but its not oil and gas. The last few were just slammed dunked with one letter, beyond disrespect suggesting where the sound is coming from. I have lived here about 30 years and am very familiar with my town.

I am very frustrated with the automatic response from a government agency always being, first we have the find a way to say this is not oil and gas related. This noise is real and potentially dangerous. Please consider my request.
