General Comment:

On 1/3/2019 COGCC staff Kris Neidel and Chevron staff; Ben Kleinsasser and Chris Paterson inspected Spill number 460478. The spill was reported as occurring on 12/13/2018. The area had been water washed as was observable by the evidence of surface flow left in dirt and melted snow. It was discussed that Chevron would sample per rule 910.b(3)B.
