MECHANICAL INTEGRITY TEST

1. Duration of the pressure test must be a minimum of 15 minutes.
2. An original pressure chart must accompany this report if this test was not witnessed by a OGCC representative. Injection wells tests must be witnessed by an OGCC representative.
3. For production wells, test pressures must be at a minimum of 300 psig.
4. New injection wells must be tested to maximum requested injection pressure.
5. For injection wells, test pressures must be at least 300 psig or average injection pressure, whichever is greater.
6. A minimum 300 psi differential pressure must be maintained between the tubing and tubing/casing annulus pressure.
7. Do not use this form if submitting under provisions of Rule 326.a.(1) B. or C.
8. OGCC notification must be provided 10 days prior to the test via Form 42.
9. Packers or bridge plugs, etc., must be set within 100 feet of the perforated interval to be considered a valid test.
